Carol,

Recognizing that visitation with an elephant is outside the bounds of normal protocol for the Sanctuary, the Board of Directors agreed that for now, you can begin walking with Tarra one day a week, without your dogs.

Let me know which day of the week Wednesday thru Saturday will work best for you so the caregivers can know what day to expect you. The best time for visiting Tarra will be between the hours of 11 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

You will just need to email or text me to let me know you will in fact be coming and what time. I'll then check with the caregivers to make sure all is well with the Girls. Your visits will be approved as long as caregivers believe it will work for the elephants. Obviously there will be times when the situation or dynamics for the elephants will preclude a visit.

Once we get the okay from the caregivers, I'll let you know and someone will meet you at the Darbytown gate to let you in and then back out.

Of course, we expect you will have completely vacated the security house before this process begins.
